20 YEARS OF WILDERNESS STEWARDSHIP




It's been over 20 years since the idea of a wilderness stewardship organization for The Bob gained momentum and financing. The first volunteer trail crew was made up of Joe Franchini, Kevin Fenimore, and two others lead by a Forest Service employee named Fred Flint. Today, the Foundation has grown

to 350 volunteers participating in 40 projects each year and Fred Flint, now retired, is still one of BMWF's biggest supporters. This year, Sarah Weddington, one of the early BMW organizers and donors, honored Fred with a generous contribution to celebrate his ata' boy persistence and endurance as one of BMWF's longest sustaining members and volunteers.

Fred's contribution to the Foundation is invaluable. He leads the Board of Directors as the President, he mentors a group of Boy Scouts on one project trip each summer, he steps up to the plate to help with key aspects of BMWF's two annual fundraisers, AND he sharpens ALL of the cross-cut saws in BMWF's tool shed.

BMWF RECEIVES LEGACY AWARD




The Forest Service awarded the Foundation with a

LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

You are part of a special community of individuals who support the stewardship of The Bob; a group that is personified by action and a "get er' done" attitude. Thanks to the strength of BMWF volunteers and the generosity of its donors, the Foundation is able to put into action the largest network of volunteer wilderness stewards in the state of Montana.

In 2015 this coordinated partnership effort:

- Provided leadership for 302 volunteers who cleared and maintained 133 miles of trail and removed 100's of bags of invasive weeds.
- Mentored the next generation of wilderness stewards by engaging 125 youth in projects that resulted in meaningful conservation outcomes.
- Launched the Wilderness Conservation Corps, a member of the 21st Century initiative to preserve the America's Great Outdoors. This dedicated intern crew, lopped, dug, and cut their way through 78 miles of trail while working to maintain wildlife habitat.
- Worked in partnership with the Forest Service, 12 cooperating organizations and 23 volunteer packers to provide service opportunities and wilderness education in The Bob.

- You are part of a special community of individuals who support the stewardship of The Bob; a group that is personified by action and a "get er' done" attitude. Thanks to the strength of BMWF reflection.

 Hosted 3 artists in wilderness cabins who shared with the public the solitude and importance of Wilderness for quiet artistic reflection.
 - Provided wilderness and outdoor education through front country programs including: The Wilderness Speaker Series and Forestry Expo.
 - Continues to bring the Telluride Mountain Film Festival to community's around The Bob each year.

When I run the "numbers" at the end of each year I am always astounded to see the result of BMWF's coordinated efforts that aggregate hard dollars with in-kind service to produce tangible outcomes. The BMWF was incorporated 20 years ago by a group of farsighted Montanans who where concerned about declining Forest Service budgets and frustrated by backlogged maintenance needs in the state's most treasured landscape. Today, BMWF raises over \$250,000 for the wilderness conservation effort and recruits volunteers who donate labor valued at \$400,000 annually. Thank you for being part of this proud community of wilderness stewards!
